

MDX System Wide Bridge Pressure Cleaning & Painting Project Fact Sheet

Project Overview

The Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) is putting toll dollars to work to improve its roadway system wide. The authority has begun a \$2.18 million construction improvement project that will provide pressure cleaning and painting to concrete bridges throughout MDX's roadway system.

Pressure cleaning and painting operations will take place daily during day time hours from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Occasional night time work may also occur between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Intermittent lane closures may occur seven days a week. Completion is scheduled for April 2008.

Project Benefits

Pressure cleaning and painting of the concrete bridges will improve the overall durability of the MDX bridges by reducing mildew growth and enhancing the longevity of the structures. Additional aesthetic benefits include facilitation of better maintenance of graffiti.
