Section 286.0105, Florida Statues states that if a person decides to appeal any decision made by a board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Any written public comments that are to be submitted to the Board shall be sent to Torey Alston, Interim GMX Executive Director, by emailing <u>executivedirector@greatermiamiexpresswayagency.com</u>. All written public comments must be received within 24 hours before the start of the meeting to be included as part of the record.

All comments will be shared with Board Members but only comments related to Board items being voted upon will be included in the record. Please indicate the agenda item number related to your comments in your email subject heading.
