1. What is the SunPass Mini?

It's the new, sleek and less expensive version used throughout Florida, in all locations SunPass is accepted. The SunPass Mini is as thin as a credit card – 2.5” and sticks right to the car windshield. Also, the SunPass Mini doesn't require batteries, which

2. How much does it cost?

The SunPass Mini is virtually free making it affordable for drivers and their families to have their own Mini tag. It's only \$4.99! As a bonus, drivers will automatically receive a \$4.99 credit after completing the registration process and opening an account with a minimum \$10 balance.

3. Can I switch it from car to car?

SunPass Mini *sticks to your windshield*. By having one owner per sticker tag, there is no more need to switch back and forth from car to car. No need to hold it up to the windshield or search for it in the car when passing through the SunPass lane. As an anti-theft precaution, the SunPass Mini can't be used once it has

4. Can I still use my transponder? Can I trade it in?

Transponders will continue to work but cannot be traded in for the SunPass Mini.

5. Where can I buy it?

SunPass Mini is available at Publix Super Markets, Navarro and Sedano's.
