## MDX TO REINSTATE TOLLS AT MIDNIGHT

MIAMI, Fla., October 9, 2016 – As impacts of Hurricane Matthew subsided, the Miami Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) will be reinstating toll collection on all of its expressways at midnight.

MDX roads include SR 836/Dolphin Expressway, SR 874/Don Shula Expressway, SR 924/Gratigny Parkway, SR 112/Airport Expressway and SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway.

MDX's Road Rangers will be operating as usual, providing free roadside assistance to distressed motorists. Drivers can contact Road Rangers by dialing \* FHP (347).

South Florida motorists are advised to adhere to warnings and there were no storm-related incidents on any of the MDX expressways.
