Mainline Closure

Alternate lanes on eastbound and westbound SR 878 will be closed just past the SR 826/Palmetto Expressway for utility improvements. The closure will take place nightly beginning **Monday, May 17 through Friday, May 21 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.**

Mainline Closure

Alternate lanes on westbound SR 878 will be closed intermittently just past SW 87th Avenue (Galloway Road) for utility installation. The intermittent closure will take place nightly beginning **Monday, May 17 through Friday, May 21 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.**

Mainline Closure

The right lane on westbound SR 878 will be closed just past SW 87th Avenue (Galloway Road) to remove a temporary support structure. The closure will take place on **Tuesday, May 18 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**
