SR 836/Dolphin Expressway

Multiple Lane and Ramp Closures

All lanes and ramps on eastbound SR 836 will be closed between NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) and NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) for steel beam erection. The closure will take place for 6 hours on **both Sunday, June 27 and Monday, June 28 from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Eastbound Detour:

Motorists wishing to continue on eastbound SR 836 should exit at NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) and turn right. Continue south on NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) and turn left at NW 7th Street. Continue east on NW 7th Street and turn left at NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). Continue north on NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to access the ramp to eastbound SR 836 on the right. Motorists wishing to access eastbound SR 836 from NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) should also detour through NW 7th Street.

Lane Closure

Alternate lanes on eastbound and westbound SR 836 will be closed between NW 17th Avenue and NW 7th Avenue for pressure washing. The closure will take place for 8 hours nightly beginning **Sunday, June 27 through Wednesday, June 30 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Lane Closure

Two left lanes on eastbound and westbound SR 836 will be closed between NW 72nd Avenue (Milam Dairy Road) and NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) for median barrier wall construction. The closure will take place for 8 hours nightly beginning **Monday, June 28 through Saturday, July 3 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

FDOT Lane Closure

The contractor for the SR 826/SR 836 Interchange Reconstruction Project will perform the following closure:

Monday, June 28 through Thursday, July 1 - There will be on and off single lane closures on eastbound and westbound SR 836 between NW 87th Avenue and SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to allow the contractor to safely work on the shoulder. The closures will take place between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Lane Closure

Alternate lanes on eastbound and westbound SR 836 will be closed between NW 37th Avenue and NW 27th Avenue for pressure washing. The closure will take place for 8 hours on **both Wednesday, June 30 and Thursday, July 1 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Lane Closure

The right lane on westbound SR 836 will be closed between NW 45th Avenue and NW 57th Avenue (Red Road) for traffic surveillance camera installation. The closure will take place for 8 hours on **both Wednesday, June 30 and Thursday, July 1 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**
